A small group met and formed the Ocean Springs Art Association in the Fall of 1971 to promote friendship and good fellowship among those persons engaged in the visual arts.

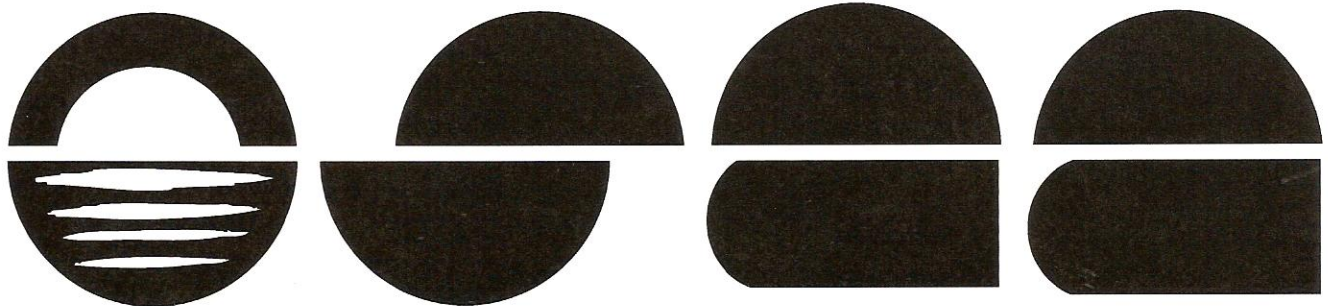
