

SUPPLY LIST FOR INTRODUCTION TO PASTEL LANDSCAPES BY BETH ANN MACDONALD

- A variety of soft and hard pastels. If you already have some, don't go out and purchase extra just for the class. If you need to purchase, I'm recommending you get these two sets:
 - Hard Pastel: 24 Count of Assorted NuPastel
Currently \$28 on Dick Blick and \$26 on Amazon
 - Soft Pastel: 30 Count Half Stick Landscape set of Sennelier
Currently \$32 on Dick Blick and \$61 on Amazon

I will have some of both recommended sets for purchase (\$31 for the NuPastel and \$35 for the Sennelier)
- UArt Light 400 or 600 Grit Pastel Paper
You will need 2-3 18" x 24" Sheets of Light UArt. We will cut these down to our needed sizes. You could purchase packs of the 9" x 12" instead, but the larger sheets are more cost-effective. UArt is preferred for the methods I will be teaching but LuxArchival will also work.
Currently an 18" x 24" is \$12.45 per sheet on Dick Blick (or \$11.25 each if you buy at least 10 sheets). You can purchase the 9" x 12" packs on Amazon, Dick Blick, or Jerry's Artorama.
I will have sheets available for purchase for \$12.50. I will also have a paper cutter and scissors available for use to cut down sheets.
- Backer Board
This is just something to tape your paper too. You can use a drawing board, Gator Board, MDF panel, etc.
I will have some thick Foam Core available for purchase for \$3.50
- Standing or Table Easel
You will need an easel to use, Standing or Table for your preference. It is preferable to have one that can hold artwork vertically. I have a few that I will bring in case someone needs to borrow one.
- Artist Tape
You will need to have some low-tack tape to tape your paper to your backer board. I prefer ProArt or Dick Blick ½" in Black or white. But you can use anything including Washi tape and Office Masking tape.
- Wet Wipes, Baby Wipes, Finger Cots, or Latex/Nitrile Gloves
This is personal preference. If you use gloves to protect your hands, please make sure that they fit. If the fingers are too long, they will interfere with how you are able to use your pastel. Sometimes I wear gloves but most of the time, I wipe my hands with baby wipes. The lanolin or moisturizers in baby wipes keep your hands from drying out.
- Glassine, Wax Paper, Tracing Paper, or Clear Bags
I prefer to use clear bags to transport and protect my artwork. Glassine is the traditional way to protect your artwork, but Wax Paper and Tracing Paper can be used in a pinch.
I will have Clear Bags available for purchase for \$.25 each
- Paper Towels
- Trash Bag
- Photo landscape references. I will provide references for you to paint from but if you want to try your own on the last day, please bring some.

I will accept Cash, Check, or Venmo for anything you purchase from me. The price you are getting is just what I paid for it (item plus the tax).
